Adopt A Tree Program

The City of Largo Parks Division is proud to offer the **Adopt A Tree Program**. This program allows residents who live in the City of Largo to purchase a tree through the Parks Division, at wholesale cost, and have it planted on their property. Residents may choose to plant up to 2 trees per property.

The Parks Division will plant the tree anywhere on the property that is suitable for the type of tree selected. Location must be approved by the Parks Division and not be close to power lines or interfere with any underground utilities or sidewalks.

Residents must agree to:

- Water the tree 3 times per week for up to two years (***tree care guidelines will be provided***)
- Maintain a mulch ring around the tree
- Keep the mulch ring weed free
- Sign a waiver and agreement of responsibility for the tree

The following trees are available (30-45 gallon, 2-3" caliper):

- Live oak
- Red Maple
- Sycamore
- Slash Pine
- Sweetgum
- Red Cedar
- Southern Magnolia
- Bald Cypress

The typical wholesale cost for a tree is between **\$150-\$200**.

Residents must sign a waiver for Parks staff to enter their property and understand that care and maintenance of the tree is the responsibility of the homeowner after the tree is installed.

I agree to purchase a tree at wholesale cost through the Largo Parks Division. I understand that ownership and care of the tree is my responsibility after the tree has been planted by the Parks Division.
